


What is the Security Framework?

Accelerator Enables static site generation via the Dynamic Site Rendering (DSR) method. Cached content is served to visitors until invalidated by updates in the WordPress backend.

What is Accelerator?

Accelerator converts your website into a static version using the Dynamic Site Rendering (DSR) method. The first visitor to your site generates a cached version, which is then stored until it is invalidated.

Does Accelerator support server-side processing?

Yes, by default, all POST requests are directed to the origin instance unless they are stopped by SiteBox Enclave. This setup allows using existing functionalities or the option to disable them completely, thereby making WordPress invisible to users.

How long does Accelerator cache the content?

Accelerator caches content in object storage until it is invalidated. This can happen in two ways: by manually flushing the cache in the SiteBox dashboard or by applying changes to the content on your WordPress instance.
